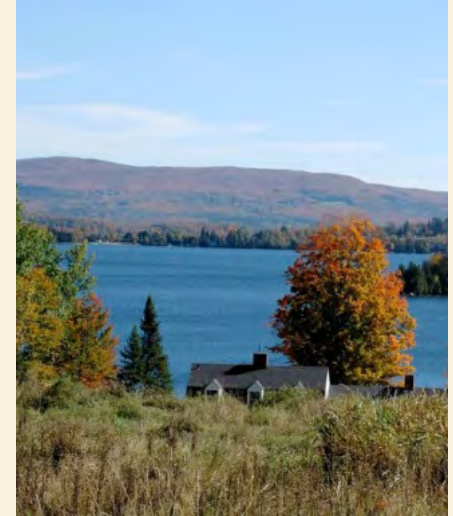

## What is The Fund for Greensboro?

*The Fund for Greensboro* consists of two funds dedicated to social, educational, cultural, recreational, human service and environmental initiatives in Greensboro and the surrounding region.
